2. Recall that you presented cultural aspects of specific high and low-context countries. Attempt an in-depth discussion on the verbal and non-verbal cultural peculiarities of the country you presented. 15 marks
3. Write short notes on the following:
  - (a) High-culture context
  - (b) Low-culture context
  - (c) Cross-cultural communication
  - (d) Culture shock
  - (e) Cultural tolerance 15 marks
4. Culture and communication have a symbiotic relationship. Elaborate on the relationship between both concepts and highlight how they work together to achieve cross-cultural goals. 15 marks
5. With relevant examples, list and briefly explain the five (5) methods of managing conflicts when communicating with people from different cultures. 15 marks
6. Research has shown that more than 70 per cent of what is communicated daily is done non-verbally. Using relevant examples, explain this assertion by discussing the non-verbal communication aspects between a low context and high context country. 15 marks
