- 4. What method did you use in planting the vegetable seeds? (1 mark)
- 5. State 2 reasons for using the method stated in (4) above. (2 marks)
- 6. The seeds of one of the vegetables were boiled and later dried before planting.
- a. The seeds were for which of the vegetables? State its common and botanical name. (2 marks)
- b. Why were the seeds boiled? (2 marks)
- c. Why were they dried after boiling? (2 marks)
- 7. What is the space between two beds called? (1 mark)
- 8. State two daily practices you carried out in the course of the vegetable production. (2 marks)

- 10. State one reason for using bed for vegetable production and not a ridge (2 marks)
- 11. Why is it important to wet your bed before harvesting your vegetable? (2 marks)
- 12. State 5 precautionary measures on the farm. (5 marks)

- 13. What is brooding? What are the two chicken types under brooding at the T & R farm (3 marks)
- 14. List 4 materials and 3 different heat sources utilized for brooding of healthy chicks (5 marks).
- Which of these heat sources in (14) is preferably used on the T & R farm? Why? (2 mark)
