- 3. What social or cultural differences are evident in the long poems of two of the periods with which you are familiar? (20 marks)
- 4. Either: (a) Explain the differences in the poetry of the Augustans and the Romantic poems, with specific reference to two of the poems. (20 marks)
 - Or: (b) Write an essay on the themes and the artistic philosophies of TWO of the following poets: William Wordsworth, Percy Bysshe Shelley, William Butler Yeats, Samuel Taylor Coleridge and John Keats. (20 marks)
- 5. Critically analyse W.B. Yeats 'Among School Children' or T.S.Eliot's 'The Waste Land', paying attention to the features of the age at which the poem was written. (20 marks)
