- 3. Even though the Greeks were influenced by the Egyptian and Mesopotamian civilizations, they went far ahead of them to make important landmark inventions and wrote their name on the sand of history. With what evidence(s) would you justify this assertion? (23 marks)
- 4. "Carriers/disseminators of civilization". Does this give a plausible description of the contributions of the Phoenicians to world civilization? (23 marks)
- 5. Comment on the contributions of the Sumerians to civilization in ancient Mesopotamia. (23 marks)
- 6. The Romans were outlier as far as ancient civilization is concerned. What then do you consider the remarkable contributions of the Romans to civilization. (23 marks)
