- 4. Discuss the reasons advanced for the scramble for and partition of Africa in the 19th century.
- 5. Ethiopia recorded success in her resistance against Italian invasion unlike other African States. Discuss the factors responsible for the success of Ethiopian resistance under Emperor Menelik II.
- 6. The activities of Jaja of Opobo and Nana of Itsekiri in the Niger Delta have been interpreted as precursor to nationalist movement in Nigeria. Discuss.
